Beyond our physical properties, we are growing spiritually as a family of Christ by enhancing old and developing new ministries:

- Our 2007 New Orleans Mission Team traveled to rebuild homes damaged during Hurricane Katrina.
- Our 2008 Iowa Mission Team will leave in October to help those impacted by recent flooding.
- You will meet some mission team members at the Outreach table in the Chapel.
- We are hosting Free Community Meals on the last Thursday of every month to bring people together and to provide a free hot meal to anyone who wants to join us.
- We support the Interfaith Hospitality Network by serving dinner and spending time with homeless families when housed at Heights Christian Church two weeks each year.
- Our youth are dedicated to the long-term objective of spreading peace and harmony worldwide. Several of our teens are in Los Angeles right now meeting with Nobel Peace winners at a PeaceJam gathering

These are just a few of the ways we work as Disciples of Christ. While you are in the Chapel, you can see what our Children's Ministry was up to this summer and view historical memorabilia from when we were named Euclid Avenue Christian Church.
